## The Pastor's Corner



October 2011

Dear Friends In Christ,

How fast the summer has passed!! Already the leaves are falling to the ground and everywhere we see signs of the Fall; reds, yellows, and oranges, in bright array. Soon, the earth in our hemisphere will be clothed in its winter best – SNOW!!!! - And Christmas will be upon us. Where did the year go?

In the last newsletter I let you know that both of the Sessions had been actively engaged in discernment, and that each had found two areas of energy to for focus and further prayer. East Guilford had a successful summer with a produce table at most services. The produce either went to some of you, or to the Unadilla Food Pantry – which sends its thanks! And in case those at East Guilford missed the announcement, as of September 21, 2011, we are officially an Earth Care Congregation – the second in New York State after First Presbyterian in Ithaca. What a great achievement! Lastly, the Session is looking for someone who also feels the call to feed the hungry in our area. The Unadilla Food Pantry has had such an increase in clients that we need someone to become the director. The Session is still evaluating this mission opportunity. If you have thoughts on this, please talk to one of your Session members.

Unadilla has been continuing its discernment as well, but as you all know – we were once again flooded! “ARGH!!!!”, as Charlie Brown used to say! While

we grieve for that and for some members we have lost, we also know that when God is ready, we will have exactly what we need, exactly when we need it. The Session is exploring backpacks full of food for kids at risk and in the interest of healing the church family, the Session will engage in Healthy Congregations Training, something the presbytery offers for congregations looking to improve communication and interaction. Our first “class” will be held on Sunday, October 23, with the Rev. Mark Montfort and Elder Marilyn Myers acting as facilitators. Already, the open discussions within the Session have yielded a greater sense of openness, peace, cooperation, and involvement within the Unadilla congregation, and we not even had one workshop yet! I applaud the Session for its courage and sense of purpose and I can hardly wait to see what God has planned for us as we go forth in health and mission in the name of Jesus, the Christ.

As the church year winds down, I am thrilled and encouraged by all the work that has occurred over the past year. I love it here and am grateful for each and every one of you. When Advent is once again upon us, and we begin the church year anew, I hope that all of us will make time to pause in the midst of the holidays to remember that we are entering one of the most sacred seasons of the church year – the time when we recognize, rejoice in, and give thanks for the incarnate appearance of our God in the person of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Soli Deo Gloria!! (To God alone be the glory!)

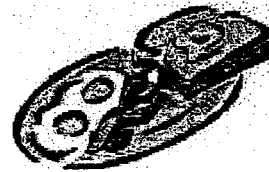

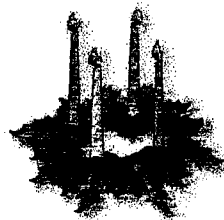


## Meshach's Facts October 2011

Dear Fellow Camel Lovers,

As I'm sure you all know, our beautiful summer has almost gone and suddenly – it is very cold! That can only mean one thing here in upstate New York - - Christmas is coming! I love Christmas and I know you all do too, but we are often soooooo busy that we forget we have a whole month to get ready for that wonderful and special day – the day Jesus was born.

The time leading up to Christmas is called "Advent". The English word comes from the Latin word *adventus*, which means "coming", and it is how the Greek word *parousia*, was translated into the Latin version of the New Testament. #### **Actions/Motions Approved:**

**Purchase of a new wireless router - \$54.** It has been determined that our Internet connection drops because the current wireless router has old firmware that cannot be changed.

**Purchase of an outdoor sign to advertise events at the church was approved - \$209.50.** It arrived on August 13<sup>th</sup> and will be placed outside.

**Movie Night Scheduled for 8/28/11 at 6:30 PM.** The movie will be "Source Code", a first run film recently released on DVD. This is part of the Session's ongoing discernment process to provide safe activities and spaces for teens at risk.

**A Stewardship Letter** was crafted by Sandy Egli, and edited and approved by the Session. It will be sent out shortly.

**Approval for the use of the Manse Fund** to make some needed repairs in the manse in September and/or October: Front railings, porch, upstairs toilet (to be donated) & chimney. The Men's Breakfast and Bible Study has been asked to do some of the work.

**Approval for donation of the Roelle organ.** The organ will go either to the Sidney Boys & Girls Club, or possibly a nursing home that needs a keyboard.

**Approval for purchase of a new vacuum cleaner.** The old one has seen better days. Approximate cost: \$ 250

**Approval for Building Use by Dan & Jean Schlafer for 10/1/11 at member rates.**

**Approval by e-mail prior to the meeting for the use of the building by the Presbytery of Susquehanna Valley on 8/2/11.**

Dave Williams reports that the Men's restroom in the narthex has been repaired.

Jan Lafayette and Tina Pabst are investigating a Nature walk to complete the requirements for East Guilford to become an Earth Care Congregation.
