Nominating Committee

The nominating committee is a committee of the congregation responsible for presenting a slate of candidates for the office of Elder at the annual meeting or at other times if a vacancy occurs.

When the pulpit is vacant and the decision is made to form a Pulpit Nominating Committee, the nominating committee will present a slate of candidates for election at the congregational meeting.

The nominating committee is made up of 4 members, two ruling elders from the session and at least two members from the congregation. The two members from the congregation will be nominated from the floor for a one year term and elected at the annual meeting. The session will appoint an elder who is beginning the first year of a three year term as ruling elder. The second session member will be in the second year of a three-year term as ruling elder who also served on the nominating committee the previous year. This second-year elder will chair and moderate the nominating committee and will be responsible for calling and conducting the meetings.
